Other credits include tour and recording engagements with Bobby Short, Ray Charles, The Pointer Sisters, and Yoko Ono, among many others. Mr. Higgins is also well known for his work on Broadway, including The Wiz, Ain't Misbehavin', Chicago, and many others, as well as numerous movie soundtracks.



Featuring Marie-Claire Giraud

Marie-Claire Giraud – a soprano, a jazz singer, musical theater singer, songwriter, composer, playwriter, actor and activist –j was born on the island of Dominica, raised in The Bronx, and started her operatic training in Rome, Italy. Marie-Claire has performed at the Barclays Center, MSG, City Hall, Small's Jazz Club, Jamaica Jazz and Blues Festivals, Cartagena Jazz Festival, Weill Recital Hall, Carniege Hall and Joe's Pub at The Public Theater to name a few. She made her Broadway debut in 2022, starring in the Tennessee Williams one act play Hello From Bertha. Awards: 2016 NYC Caribbean Heritage Award recipient, 2015 NAACP Image Award recipient, citations from NYS Senate, City Hall, and the UN.



Marco DiGennaro was born and raised in Rome, Italy, studied classical music and graduated at the Italian Conservatory of Music. Composer, improviser, arranger, during his career performed as a jazz pianist and band director/leader all over the world. Wrote and arranged music for the most important Italian theater actors and directors, putting his signature on some major Italian shows. At the age of forty, established himself in New York City, where he currently resides, playing extensively and getting to be greatly acknowledged in the greatest music scene in the world. During his career he played/recorded with many of the greatest musicians, such as Bill Saxton, Lee Konitz, Bobby Watson, Peter Bernstein, Charles Tolliver, Vincent Herring, Tony Scott, Jeremy Pelt, Steve Turre, Doug Weiss, Dwayne Burno, Joe Farnsworth, Curtis Lundy, Frank Lacy, Joe Magnarelli, Freddie Hendrix, Ron McClure and many others. In 2022 is musical director for the show From Cotton To Caviar, about Eartha Kitt, which is set out to touring in Europe.

As far as drummer **Brandon Sanders** is concerned, everyone should have a grandmother who runs a jazz club. It was at the Casablanca, his grandmother's boite in Kansas City, that he was first exposed to the music that changed his life. During summer visits from his home in Los Angeles in the mid-1970s through the late '80s, young Brandon not only encountered the music of such greats as Jimmy Smith, Grant Green, and Lou Donaldson, he also learned about their lives from the stories his grandma told him. Sanders splendid debut album, Compton's Finest may be the work of a late bloomer, but its emotional depth is the mark of a seasoned veteran. To continue, visit

What we're planning for 2024 at BPC!

In 2023, Brooklyn Peace Center focussed on renovations, launching Peace Cafe, and hosting local gatherings and events, such as the monthly makers market, a monthly artist-in-residence program, a monthly open mic, and a Maui benefit concert for Hawaians in diaspora in NYC. On Sundays, and some evenings, two faith communities share space at BPC, namely Cordero de Dio (Kichwa) and Garifuna Believers Mennonite, brining opportunities for intercultural peacebuilding.

In 2024, with newly renovated main hall and a ground floor cafe, BPC's focus will be to develop robust programs and services that promote peacebuilding through a trauma aware lens.


